Individual Course Registration and Tuition

Registration is required to attend a class. You can register online or by phone. Tuition for individual course is \$150 per class (including books) payable in advance.

Classes are open to all. The options are:

Workshops

Application Process for Certification Program

Those applying for the cohort program must:

- Be at least 18 years old
- Have obtained a high school diploma or equivalent
- Submit completed application form with \$20 application fee
- Obtain letters of recommendation as required
- Submit completed application for Kino Library card
